

ARTHUR J. TURNER, JR. SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Arthur J. Turner, Jr. Scholarship Foundation (AJTJSF) was established in 1992. The Foundation provides a one-time monetary award to underprivileged, low income graduating high school students whose desire is to further their educational endeavors. In addition, the AJTJSF helps children in New Castle County develop the reading, writing and math skills they need to complete their basic education, through the creation of "help" programs within well-established schools and community centers.

Scholarships are \$500. The AJTJSF scholarship committee selects scholarship recipients and administers the scholarship to the educational institution. The current members of the AJTJSF scholarship committee are as follows:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to receive an AJTJSF scholarship award, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

Be actively involved in extracurricular activities and/or volunteer efforts. Be accepted as a full-time student in an accredited course of study at a four year college/ university Have maintained an overall average GPA of 3.0 or above Complete an interview with an authorized AJTJSF representative(s) Submit three (3) letters of recommendation Meet income guidelines

To assist in fostering community involvement, the AJTJSF also asks scholarship recipients to provide the following:

After review and acceptance of requirements and requests above, please complete the attached scholarship application form.

We also ask that scholarship recipients and their parent/guardian attend College 101, a workshop specifically designed to provide financial and college life advice and support.

Scholarship applications may be obtained by visiting the website, <u>www.arthurjturnerjrscholarship.org</u>, or by e-mailing <u>ajtjscholarship@gmail.com</u>. The application period is January 15- May 15th of each year. Interviews will occur by June 15th. The AJTJSF scholarship committee will notify selected recipients via phone or letter no later than June 30th. If you are selected, proof of household income will be required. Award letters will be distributed at College 101, Workshop held the third Saturday in July. Award disbursement will be made shortly thereafter and disbursed to the college/university noted.
